Invitation To Bid For The Provision of 2476 Laptops for The Ministry of Education

Background

The National Information and Communication Technology Company Limited, branded as "iGovTT" (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") was incorporated in July 2009 as a state-owned enterprise to continue the realization of the National Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) Strategy for transforming Trinidad and Tobago into a knowledge-based economy.

The Company procures, project manages, implements and maintains Enterprise-Wide and major ICT solutions for Government, as well as provides value-added ICT support services to Government Ministries, Divisions and Agencies (MDAs).

The Company is therefore seeking to procure 2,476 Laptops on behalf of the Ministry of Education.

Pre-Qualification

In accordance with the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Property Act, 2015 (as amended), suppliers of goods, works and services, interested in conducting business with iGovTT **must register and seek pre-qualification** on the Office of Procurement Regulation (OPR) Procurement Depository.

Invitation to Bid

The Invitation to Bid (ITB) will be conducted via a 2 stage process as follows:

- Stage 1 Technical Submission
 - 1. Bidders shall submit ONLY their Technical submission electronically via <u>https://igov.etenderworld.tt</u>
 - 2. Bids will be evaluated using the Evaluation Criteria outlined in the ITB documents

Bidders who have been successful at Stage 1 will be invited to participate in Stage 2 – Reverse Auction

• Stage 2 – Reverse Auction

- 1. Instructions relating to the conduct of the Reverse Auction will ONLY be provided to Bidders who would have been invited after passing the Technical Evaluation
- 2. The Bidder with the lowest price at the end of the Reverse Auction shall be deemed the Preferred Bidder and will be invited via a Letter of Award to enter into a contractual arrangement with iGovTT for the supply of the laptops at their final bid price submitted at the Reverse Auction.
